

## **PETITION HEARING: TUESDAY 9TH NOVEMBER – SCOTTISH PARLIAMENT – BOOK TICKETS**

Following the successful and widely publicised formal handover of the 'Justice for Megrahi' Holyrood Public Petition last Tuesday, the JFM committee has been invited to make representations to a meeting of the Public Petitions Committee at 2 PM on 9th November . Members of the JFM committee making representations will be: Dr Jim Swire, Professor Robert Black, Mr Iain McKie and Mr Robert Forrester.

It appears that tickets for the public gallery are available for this event. Should any readers wish to attend they should apply for tickets as shown below.

### **Book tickets for a Committee Meeting**

It is possible to turn up on the day to see if tickets are available, but to avoid disappointment it is advisable to book in advance using the steps below:

1. Decide which day you would like to visit. Committees are normally held on Tuesday mornings, Tuesday afternoons and Wednesday mornings. The agenda for Committee meetings is published one week before and can be found in the Business Bulletin.
2. Decide how many tickets you wish to book. Tickets for 1 to 9 people can be booked up to 7 days in advance of the meeting. Group visits for 10 to 15 people can be arranged further in advance. Please consult the booking periods for Group tickets.
3. Book tickets by contacting Visitor Services. Please let us know whether you have any access requirements when you make your booking.
