

The Marion Ross Murder: A Decade On

Marion Ross was cruelly murdered on 8 January 1997.

Ten years later not only have the Crown Office and Strathclyde Police failed to catch her killer but they have failed to re-open the murder enquiry and investigate the circumstances surrounding her death.

Many questions remain unanswered.

- On what grounds has the decision been made not to re-open the murder enquiry?
- Why was such flawed fingerprint evidence introduced in evidence?
- Why have the mistakes been covered up for so long?
- Did police and /or fingerprint experts conspire to convict David Asbury?
- What enquiry was carried out to eliminate principal suspect Patrick Docherty?
- Was there a 'Lockerbie connection'?

Answers to these and many more questions will be suggested in the forthcoming book *'Shirley McKie – The Price of Innocence'* to be published in April 2007.
